1. Introduction

As a part of the school's commitment to the global community, scholarships are offered with the objective to provide young, able students with a good educational training at a reputable British Curriculum international school in Thailand. Bromsgrove is sure that by studying in Thailand, students' talents will improve and they will gain higher level of confidence.

The scholarship does not cover the cost of air fares and visas.

2. Age Range

Candidates should normally fall be 16+ by 1st September in the year of application. The scholars will be for the sixth form, A levels programme at the school.

3. General Criteria

- The award of this scholarship is based on excellent attitude and personality.
- The applicant must have the ability to lead in their respective area with courage, integrity and compassion.
- The applicant must have personal accomplishments beyond the traditional measures of academic achievement. This may include evidence of work experience, community service involvement or personal accomplishments.
- We welcome applicants from diverse countries and cultures around the world.
- All candidates are expected to be outstanding role models for younger students.

4. Specific Criteria

- Academic - These awards are given on the basis of academic excellence, evidence of leadership skills and moral qualities. There will be a focus on students entering the sixth form - Years 12.

The scholarship is a percentage of the tuition and boarding fees. It does not include airfare, visa, uniform, trips and examination fees.

Award winners are entitled to use the name “Scholar of Bromsgrove International School Thailand” in university applications.

6. Selection Process

The selection process will be conducted in the country of origin. The School’s decision is final and there will be no right to appeal.

7. Application procedure and timeline

The application process will be carried out in February to March of each year. The scholarship will take effect from Term 1 of the following academic year. The process will take the following form;

March 1-19	Scholarships announced. Application forms completed and submitted to the school by email to admissions@bromsgrove.ac.th The application form and other required documents are found at the end of this document (page 5 onwards)
March 19	Closing date for applications
March 22-26	Short-listing applicants, Candidates contacted
March 27-28	Examinations and Interview with Headmaster Scholarship offered to the successful applicants

N.B. Any offer of a scholarship must be taken up within 3 months of the offer, otherwise the scholarship may be withdrawn or offered to an alternative candidate.

Accompanying the application should be:

- A copy of your child’s latest school report (translated into English where necessary).
- Photo
- A copy of the child’s birth certificate or passport

All applicants will sit a standard Bromsgrove entrance test. This comprises:

1. A Non-verbal Reasoning (NVR) Test
2. Mathematics test
3. English Test

8. Conditions

The scholar

- Will complete all work to his or her best ability in the context of the policies of the selected school, and follow all rules and guidelines that are laid down.
- Will contribute to the school by participating in performances and/or extra curriculum exhibitions as appropriate.
- Will act as a role model for other students in terms of commitment and conduct and being a positive support to the School and its teachers and students.

If the scholar fails to meet the above standards or noticeably fails to keep up with the level of his or her capability, the scholarship may be rescinded. At least one formal warning in writing will be given to the student and the parents prior to the withdrawal of the scholarship.

The school

Will offer the same programme as other students at the schools including:

- A flexible programme of curriculum studies in line with the English National Curriculum.
- Time off or on campus for 'high-profile' performances or marketing for the school.
- Appropriate facilities and support for students to practise their skills on campus.

Notice of Withdrawal

Parents who wish to withdraw the student from the school may do so, but are requested to give one term's notice.
