

Sixth Form Dress Code (Years 12-13) (From September 2010)

The Sixth Form encourages smart, stylish dress which expresses our students' self-confidence, pride and sense of the standards expected in business and professional work places.

Male Dress Code:

- A business-type suit or tailored jacket (grey or black)
- A long-sleeved shirt with collar
- A school tie of their choice (tied high to cover the top shirt button)
- Smart Trousers (grey or black)

Female Dress Code:

- A business-type suit or tailored jacket (short or long-sleeves)
- Pastel coloured shirt/top with short or long sleeves. Light coloured stripes allowed.
- Smart Skirt/Trousers (grey or black)

Footwear: Black or grey closed-toe shoes with no more than 1.5 inches heels

NB. Health & Safety regulations do not allow students taking practical subjects to wear open toed footwear.

Denim/leather/jeans are not allowed.

Facial piercing is not appropriate

Extremes of fashion are not acceptable in a school with younger students.

The School reserves the right to decide what is considered appropriate.

The point is to be business-like as well as stylish.
