

**Early Years Campus Teaching Team for 2015/16 Academic Year**

With the exception of Pre-Nursery, which we expect to grow to two classes from January, we are delighted that every year group in Early Years will have two classes from August. In addition, some exciting campus developments will leave many learning spaces significantly enhanced for the new academic year. All in all, therefore, August will be an exciting time for your child at Early Years. The teaching team will be as follows:



I have introduced Hannah Bennett (Primary Principal) and Charlotte Greaves (Assistant Principal EY campus) to you previously, and our new Reception parents already have an excellent relationship with Asha Savage from their children's time in Pre-Nursery and Nursery. Thai will continue to be taught by K. Kittima (Kitty) Nurak, Music by Ms Catherine Frisbie and PE by Ms Alison Bedford. In addition, Mr David Ridley, who has spent mornings at Early Years this year, will become a full-time teacher of EAL on the Early Years campus from August, thereby enhancing further our EAL provision for our youngest pupils. And our new teachers are as follows:

**Pre-Nursery – Ms Charlotte Curtis**

Charlotte joined BIST at the start of Term 3 this current academic year. Previously, Charlotte worked at an Early Years School and Kindergarten in Bangkok. A few words from Charlotte are shown below:

*'My name is Charlotte and I teach pre-nursery at Bromsgrove. I graduated from the University of Cambridge in 2009 and completed my masters degree at Cambridge in 2011. Since then I have taught in outstanding schools in the UK, and in Bangkok following my move to Thailand with my partner Matthew. I love piano and all creative arts, and enjoy exploring countries by bicycle and hiking up mountains.'*

**Nursery Teacher – Ms Hayley Albery**

Hayley is currently based in the UK and is working as a Reception teacher at Victoria Infant and Nursery School. Hayley has worked in the same school since 2009 and has taught in both the Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1. A few words from Hayley are shown below:

*'My name is Hayley Albery and I will be teaching in the Nursery at BIST. I graduated from the University of Cumbria in 2009 with a BA Honours in English with Qualified Teacher Status (QTS). Since then, I have been a teacher in an outstanding Early Years School, where I have had experience teaching in a variety of year groups. ### **Reception Teacher – Ms Sophie Aldis**

Sophie is currently based in the UK and is working at the Air Balloon Hill Primary School as a Year 2 class teacher. Previously, Sophie worked at a Catholic primary school as a Year 1 teacher. A few words from Sophie are shown below:

*'My name is Sophie Aldis and I will be teaching in Reception. I graduated in 2008 with a BSc. honours degree in Mathematics. I went on to gain my PGCE (Primary) from Warwick University in 2010 and remained in the area teaching for 3 years at a Catholic primary school. Two years ago I moved to Bristol and I am currently in my 5th year of teaching. All five of my years in teaching have been in KS1 which I have loved and I am now looking forward to teaching in the Early Years. I love reading and I love to share this love with my classes.
