EY Campus Library Book deposit for 2015/2016 academic year

As of the start of the new academic year 2015/2016 we will be bringing in a deposit system for our library books. In order for your child to take home books from our Early Years Library you will be required to pay a 1000 Baht deposit at the beginning of the academic year. If at the end of the academic year all borrowed books have been returned you will receive back your deposit in full. Please note that for any unreturned book you have the choice of either independently buying an exact replacement or incur a fine of 500 Baht per book.

Morning Drop Off for 2015/2016 academic year

In addition to our main front gate, as of the start of the new academic year 2015/2016 you will be able to use our side gate to drop off your child. The driving direction remains the same as before, entering at the front of the school and exiting onto Ramkamheang 164. Please note that the side gate will **only be open between the hours of 7:30am – 8:00am**. After this time, access will only be through our front gates. However, this drive can be used by cars as through road until 8:30am.

Pre-Nursery to Year 1 Primary Class Allocations

As BIST's reputation continues to grow we have an unprecedented amount of applications from families requesting that their children start with us in August 2015. We know how important being in the right class is for your child's social and emotional development and we want to make sure that your child is in a class with peers that will support, engage and challenge them.
